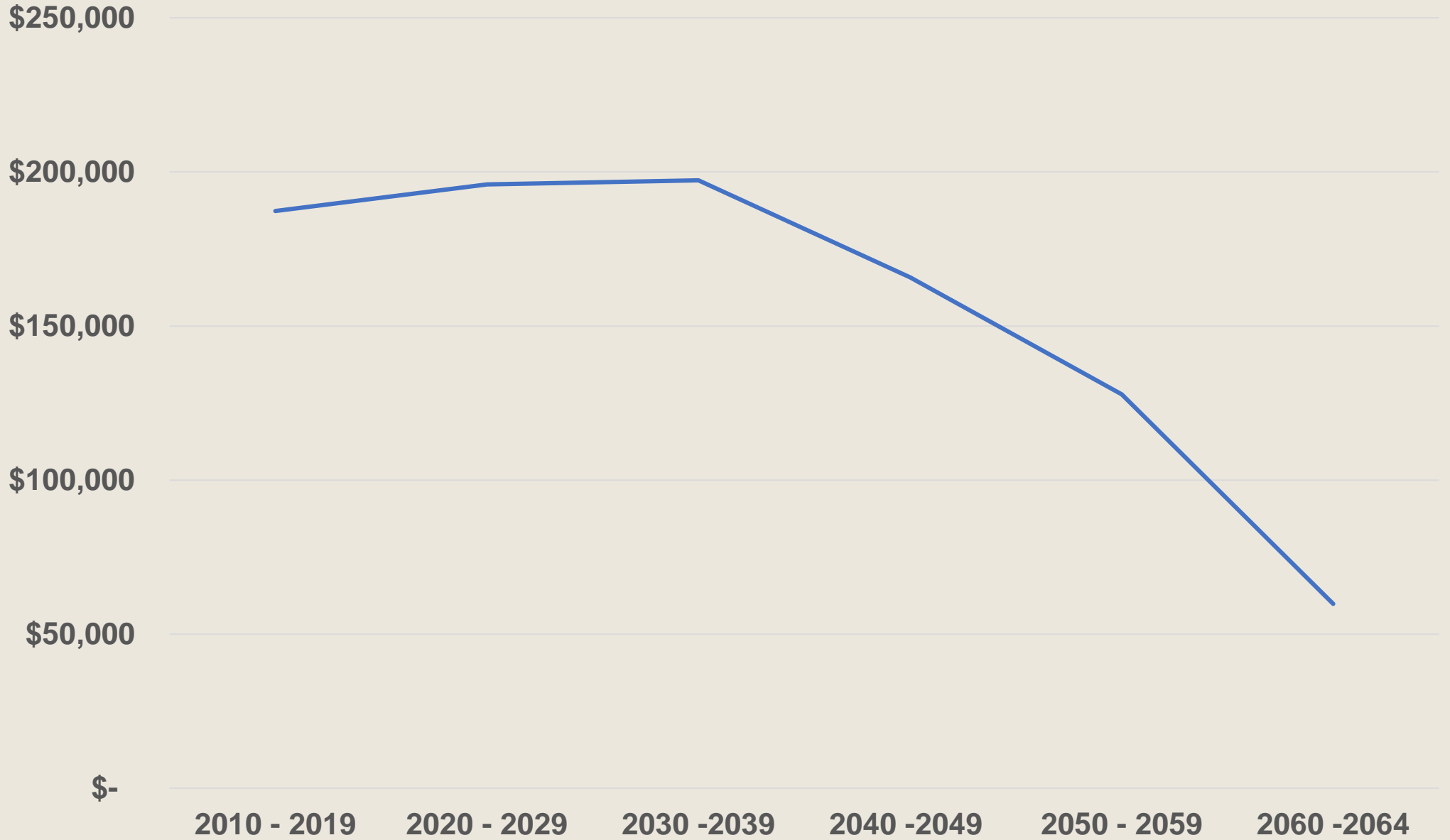

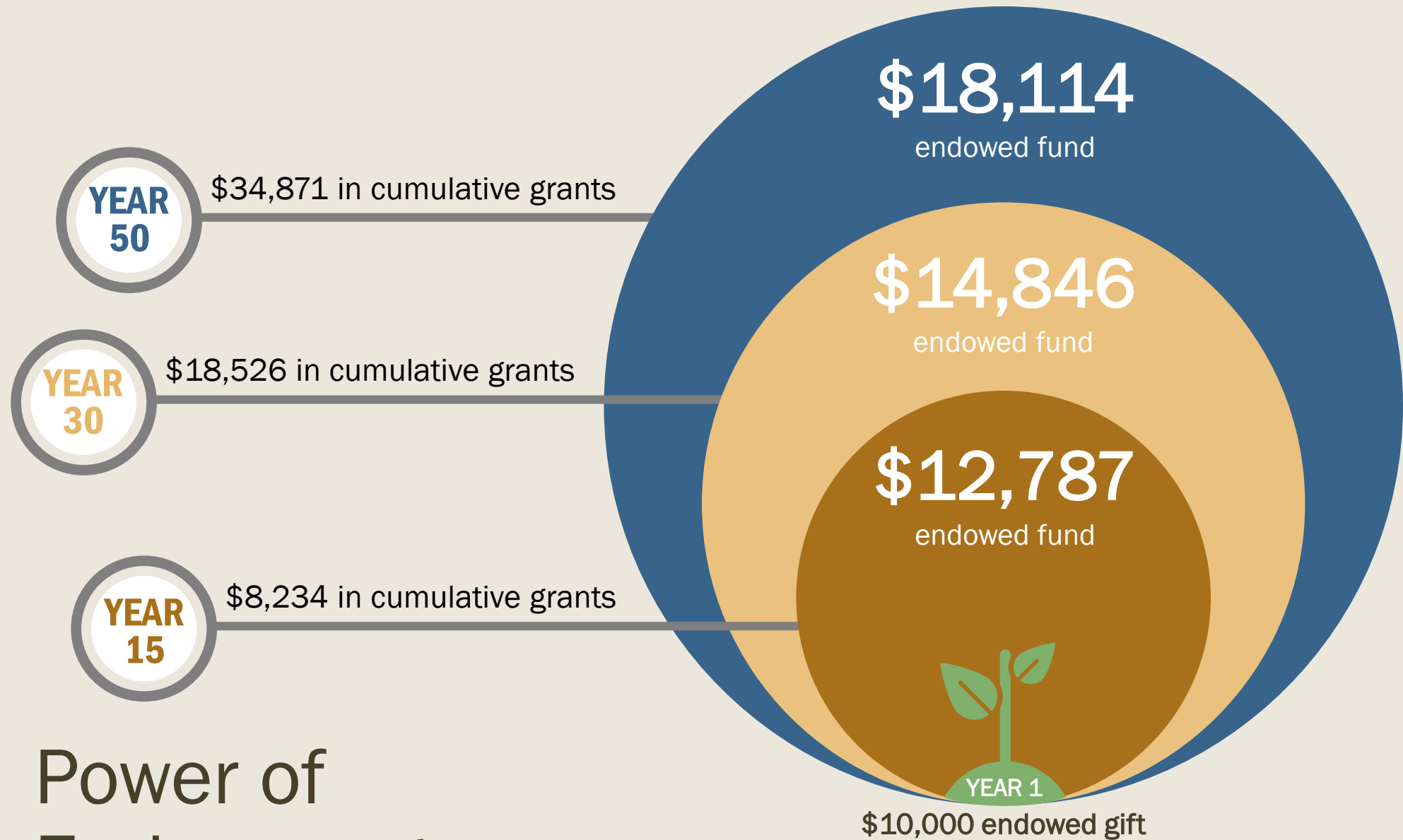

Qualifying community foundations who raise the full \$50,000 can earn an operational grants of:

- **\$5,000** spendable
- **\$20,000 endowed** to establish or add to an endowed administrative fund

Grants are pro-rated for those who raise less than \$50,000.

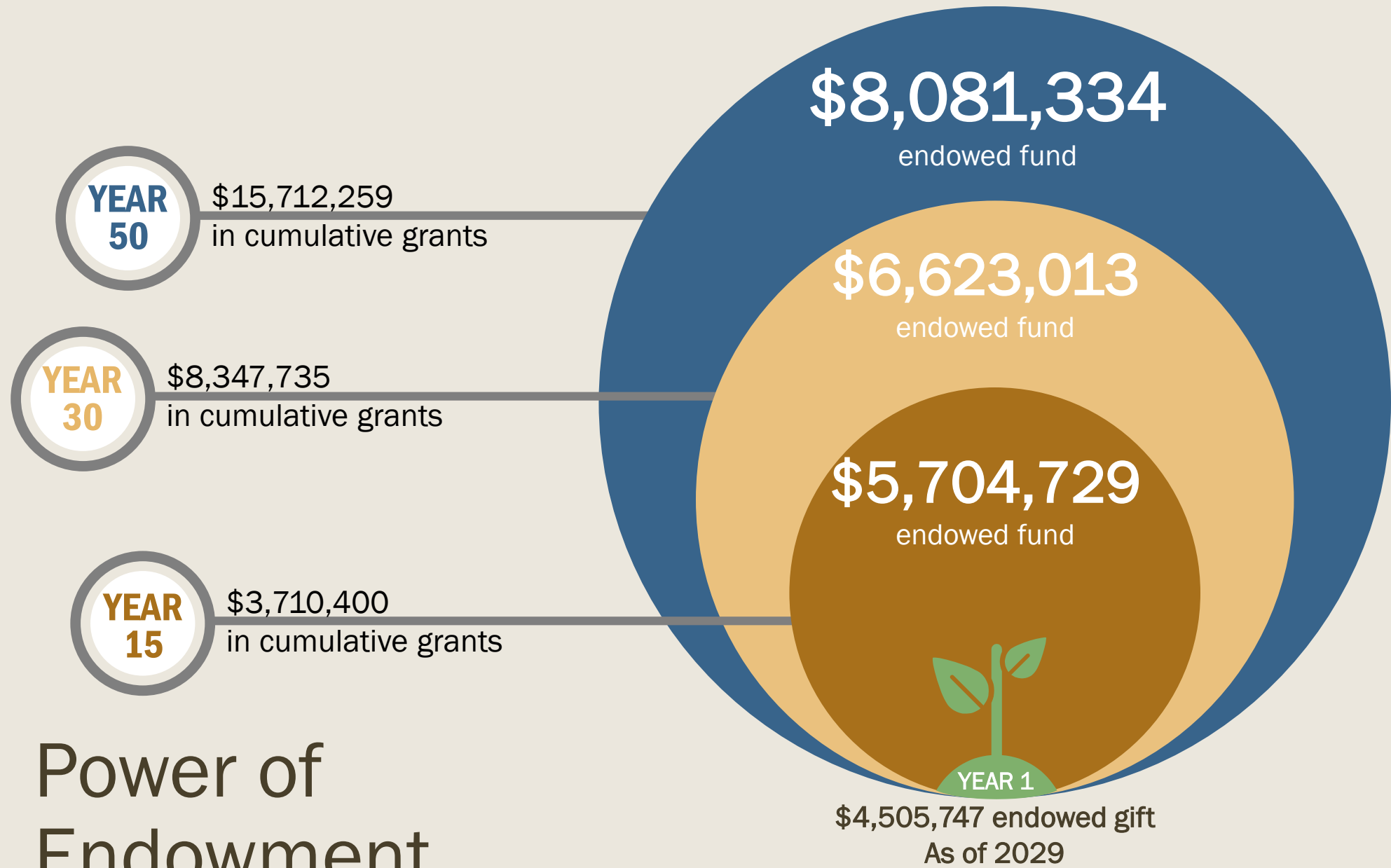
